He and another young man from St. Matthew's Troop 306 in Ellet are members of the University of Toledo Rocketry Club and they will be conducting Space Exploration Merit Badge Saturday February 24th from 10 am to about 2 pm. This will be at the Manatoc Parade Field Shelter behind the Administration Building. That is where we will build the rockets and then launch them from the parade field. The Troop will provide the Rocket Kits and the engines for the launches. The Rocket construction must be done that day and each Scout must launch his Rocket twice.

The Merit Badge has other requirements that Scouts need to prepare for ahead of time. We will discuss this at the February 20th Troop meeting. Anyone wishing to get a jump on it can go to http://meritbadge.org/wiki/index.php/Space_Exploration and print the requirements and workbook. I will have the workbooks at the Troop meeting on the 20th also. This is a fun and interesting Merit Badge. Scouts will need to sign up on Tuesday.
