A couple months ago the Troop announced a second high adventure for 2019. This is at the Red River Gorge in southern Kentucky. There is much to do at the Gorge and it is highly recommended by Tim Knight (son Justin is an Eagle from Troop 390) who has taken groups there several times. It is a great place for camping, hiking and has a terrific natural rock wall for climbing and repelling. The wall has different areas for varying levels of climbers.

Since announcing this second high adventure several months ago, we have had no one show an interest. The Troop Committee decided that we should move the date away from the time that our Philmont Scouts will be gone in order to permit them to do both Philmont and the Red River Gorge, if they wish. We discussed this at Troop closing last week and several Scouts have indicated an interest. The Philmont Crew is gone from Jun 15 to June 28 and the 4th of July is the next week, so the best dates for the Red River Gorge Trek are to start Sunday or Monday, July 7 or 8 and return July 11 or 12. That gives Scouts a couple days to prepare for Summer Camp which is the week of July 14 to 20.

We need Scout and parent input to know what participation we will have in the Red River Gorge Trek. It makes for a tight timeframe with Summer Camp, but it will be a great event. Our price of \$250 is extremely low for a five day adventure and the Scouts will remember it for a long, long time. If there is minimal interest we will not do it in 2019 and will consider it for 2020 or beyond. We request your input by our third Troop Supper, January 8.
