Summer Camp is Coming Up 7/14-21 !

Troop 390 and Troop 7390 will go to Summer Camp at Camp Manatoc in Peninsula, during Week #5, **July 14-21.** That is Sunday at about 1:00 pm to Saturday about 10:00 am. Each day Monday – Friday there are Advancement and Merit Badge Classes predominantly in the mornings. Afternoons most areas are open for the Scouts to do things they wish for their enjoyment or to practice for their classes.

Summer Camp fees are $300 \quad 5/14/19 - 7/5/19$ $315 \quad 7/6 - 7/14$ The earlier the scouts sign up the better chance they have of getting the classes that they want.

First year campers usually take a T-2-1 class to get a jump on rank advancement plus 1 or 2 Merit Badges.

Swim tests are available on 6/8 and 6/15 at Camp Manatoc from 12-4 each day. This is only needed if you missed the test conducts at CFHS on 3/18/19.

We need all 3 parts of the <u>BSA Health Forms</u>! Physicals (completed part C) need completed by a practitioner. We also need a copy of the front and back of your insurance card accompanying all 3 parts. Please turn these in ASAP.

NOTE: There is a Physical Day planned at Manatoc on 6/8 at the Health Lodge from 12-4 for only \$10 per physical, provided by Western Reserve Hospital.
