Our Scouts have a chance to learn to shoot shotguns at clay pigeons. This will be at Copley Trap Range, 1665 Jacoby Rd., Copley. Scouts can learn to shoot if they are new to shotgun shooting or Scouts who have a partial in Shotgun Shooting merit badge may be able to finish the shooting requirement. Scouts need to commit by Tuesday October 22 and Parents will need to sign a waiver and a permission slip for the Scout also. I will convey our count to the range so they can have enough trainers for us. The Troop is paying the cost of shooting.

Tuesday, October 22 is our Troop Open House date. We invite Packs in our area to bring their Webelos who will be crossing over to a Troop in the Spring to visit and learn about our Troop.
