We have had no response from parents to this question from last month's Newsletter. So we will repeat it.

Great Trail Council has said any Troop camping must be at BSA Council camps in Ohio due to the virus restrictions. As much as we would like to camp at places other than Council Camps we have not. We could camp elsewhere if we were to make it a family camp. Any Scout with a parent(s) could attend. If you are interested and would participate, please let us know. We will plan that for next spring starting with Wright Paterson if we want to make it a campout. Otherwise it would have to be a day activity. Dover Dam Days at Camp Tuscazoar, Bike/Camp/Canoe and the Astronomy Campout all may require Parent participation if the Council Rules remain in effect.

We are in the process of re-chartering all members of our Troops. Troop 390 paid the annual re-charter fees for Scouts, Leaders and Committee Members for over 25 years. We do not collect for the annual re-charter like most Units do. The fee this year for Scouts is \$66 plus \$12 for Boys' Life. That is why all Scouts and Parents are asked to participate in our fund raising activities. Adult Leader and Committee Member fees are \$42. An additional \$75 is charged each Unit for Liability Insurance. The total fees for 2021 for both Troops could exceed \$3,000.
